Spring Term Curriculum

Our theme for this term is 'Creepy Crawlies'. We plan to cover the following objectives: English

• Through Read, Write Inc phonics Programme, we will develop our reading and writing skills. In our Extended Writing lessons we will learn to use adjectives to describe characters and settings in our own short stories. We will then move on to write fact books about our favourite mini-beasts and bugs.

Maths

• We will extend our knowledge on the value of numbers and apply it to money. We will learn to sort and identify the value of different combinations of coins. We will explore times in the day and how we use different vocabulary to order event. We will also explore making groups and sharing equally as part of our early work on multiplication and division.

Science

• We will be exploring how humans and plants grow and change during a life cycle. We will then move on to the importance of a healthy lifestyle and diet.

Humanities

In History, we will be learning about how the natural world has changed over time. We will be
thinking about how creatures have become endangered or extinct. In Geography, we will be
looking for hot and cold locations around the world and explore the seasonal weather of the
UK.

Computing

• We will be learning to give commands to different computer programs to make a character move or to complete a task. We will also explore programming a moving device to control its movements.

RE

• We will explore the faiths of Hinduism and Sikhism. We will compare the lifestyles of families to our own and find out about the role of nature and water in these faiths.

PSHE

• Our 'emotions' work will look at managing 'big' feelings and how we can get help and support. In our 'relationships' work we will look at different types of families and the common features of family life.

Art and DT

 We will be developing our observational skill to improve our drawing skills and colour selection. In DT we will be making mini-beast models and masks.

Music

• In Music, we will explore using different percussion instruments and our voices to create a creepy crawly 'soundscape' and using puppets and masks to act out a story.

ΡE

We will develop our flexibility and strength by creating movements to music and participating in multi-skill activities. We will develop our Racket Sports skills by using a range of bats and nets, which will help our hand and eye coordination and spatial awareness.


<u>PE Kit</u>
