Curriculum

During the Spring Term we will be covering the following areas -

English

Our main text is 'Gulliver's Travels'. We will be working on developing
writing skills. We will be looking at grammar and punctuation to improve our
writing. We will continue to work on learning basic spellings, presentation
and speaking and listening skills.

Maths

Our focus will be on 'Calculations'. We will be looking at all four operations
and using them to solve problems with real-life problems such as rent and
bills. We will continue to work on mental maths skills including rapid recall of
number facts and times tables.

Options

As part of our options we will be working on a range of different activities
depending on the option chosen. The first half of term the options selected
are Childcare or Photography. The second half of term the options
selected are Volunteering or Car Care.

RE

 This term we will be looking at Hinduism and Sikhism. We will look at key beliefs and how these impact daily life choices e.g. food eaten. We will compare these with our own daily choices.

PSHCE

 We will continue to learn about next steps after school. We will also learn about contraceptives and STIs.

Cooking

• We will continue to work on basic skills in cooking. We will prepare dishes that we can make on our own. This will help us with our independent skills.

Vocational

• We will work on planning a trip within a budget. We will look at costings, paperwork, permissions etc.

Year 12 Ways to Support

Year 13 Ways to Support

- * Make sure you attend the EHCP meeting, when asked.
- * If your child is staying onto Year 14. Please continue to look at options/attend open days etc. This will help you make decisions during the Autumn term of Year 14.
- * Continue to work on developing independence skills as home.

- * Please make sure they attend relevant interviews and let the school know when they have secured a place.
- * Make sure they attend transition days.
- * Talk about emotions, feeling nervous is normal. There are social stories available on our website, if needed.
