During the Summer Term we will be covering the following areas -

#### English

Our topic is 'Leisure'. Our main text will be 'The Tempest'. We will be focusing
on leisure activities in Milton Keynes and making a presentation about them. We
will read the Tempest and find out some facts about William Shakespeare.

#### Maths

Our focus will be on knowledge of 'Data Handling'. We will be looking at
different ways of collecting and presenting data in tables, charts, diagrams and
pictograms. We will continue to work on basic number facts and times tables.

#### Science

• We will be exploring Solids, Liquids and Gases. We will look at the basic properties of each one. We undertake a range of practical activities.

#### **Options**

As part of our options we will be working on a range of different activities
depending on the option chosen. In D of E we will be looking at expeditions. In
Art we will continue to work with a range of materials. In cooking lessons we
will continue to prepare and cook a range of snacks and meals.

#### Computing

We will be looking at how ICT is used in different ways in a place of work.

 We will be exploring different religious beliefs about relationships and contribution to charity.

#### **PSHCE**

 We will learn about basic first aid skills, including dealing with bleeding. We will also look at fertility.

#### Life Skills

• We will develop key living skills about looking after the local environment.
