Summer Term Curriculum

Our theme for the Summer Term is 'The Romans'.

English

- We will follow the 'Read, Write, Inc' scheme to secure our sound knowledge, and use this to become more skilled, confident readers and writers. We will use the roman topic to write character description and discussion texts.

Maths

- We will continue to work on number and place value including: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and fractions. We will also explore measures, geometry and statistics.

Science

- We will identify and classify living things and learn about variations in animals.

Humanities

- We will investigate how the Roman Empire was formed and the impact of the Roman's on British civilisations.

Computing

- We will continue to develop our knowledge of computing skills as well as finding out how to use 'Office Software' with a focus on text and graphics.

RE

- We will be exploring the places of worship, and the sacred texts of Islam and Buddhism.

PSHCE

- We will learn about drugs, healthy life style and relationships.

Art and DT

- We will make mosaics in a typically Roman style, as well as create a gladiator's sandal!

Food Technology

We will learn about baking and follow simple recipes to make muffins and cakes.

Music

- We will listen and move to music in relation to the theme of animals. In addition we will compose and perform music inspired by 'Carnival of the Animals' by Saint Seans. In drama, we will explore the life of a gladiator through creating a short script and props.
